

MICHIGAN CHAPTER BY-LAWS

1. Membership Classes

Active Members - may participate in all activities, provided that their dues are paid.
Lifetime Members - may participate in all activities; dues waived.
Honorary Members - may participate in all activities; dues waived.
Associate Members - may participate in all activities, provided that their dues are paid, except that they may not hold elected office. Ownership of a T series or vintage MG is not necessary.
Lifetime and Honorary Members are determined by the Executive. The spouse of any member is also considered a member. All members at the end of the 1970 - 1971 fiscal year are considered Charter Members.
2. Dues

The dues are \$15.00 per year, due January 1st.
3. Fiscal Year

The fiscal year is April to March, ending March 31st.
4. Executive Meetings

Executive meetings will be held when deemed necessary by the Chairman or either Vice-Chairman. The Executive consists of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Second Vice-Chairman, Recording Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Chairman.
5. Quorums

Executive - an Executive Quorum must be comprised of not less than 50% of the elected officers.
General - a General Quorum must be comprised of not less than 25% of the membership.
6. Committees

The following committees with the indicated responsibilities will be appointed by the Executive.
Regalia - the Regalia Committee shall be responsible for the planning, ordering, stocking and sale of Michigan Chapter Regalia items.
Technical Library - the Technical Library Committee shall organize, index and maintain a technical reference library for use by the membership.
BSCC - the BSCC (British Sports Car Council) Committee shall be responsible for attending BSCC meetings and representing the Michigan Chapter's interests at such meetings.
"T -Times" - The "T-Times" Committee shall consist of the "T-Times" Editor(s) and Advertising Representative. The Editor(s) shall be the Michigan Chapter's correspondent to "The Sacred Octagon" (NEMGTR magazine). The Advertising Representative shall be responsible for all classified and paid "T-Times" advertising.
Midwest MGT Steering Committee Representative (s) shall represent the interests of the Michigan Chapter at all meetings of the Midwest MGT Steering Committee.
7. Expenditures

All Michigan Chapter expenditures must be approved by the Executive. Net revenues generated by Michigan Chapter sponsored GOF Centrals shall be handled in accordance with normal Michigan Chapter fiscal requirements, after first establishing a reserve of \$500.00 to be used solely for the promotion and funding of future GOF Central events.
Loans and other advances to other Chapters shall be approved by the Executive, and must be repaid fully within two weeks following the respective event.
8. Activities

All activities organized by, or participated in by any person or group in the name of the Michigan Chapter, must be approved by the Executive.
9. Publications

The official publication of the Michigan Chapter is the "T -Times", a newsletter published regularly, as determined by Michigan Chapter BY-Laws.
